

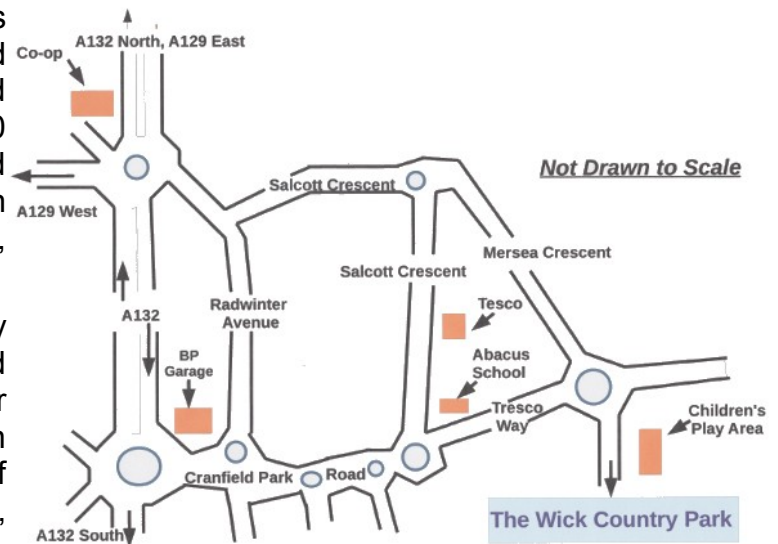


# The Wick Country Park



The Wick Country Park is Wickford's hidden treasure. Owned and managed by Basildon Borough Council, it is located just off Tresco Way, Wickford. The 50 acre Park has 2km of trails that lead past old hedgerows, through wide open meadows, past the five acre lake, ponds, WW2 pillboxes and woodlands.

A large *children's play area* is situated by the entrance to the Park. Car parking and cycle racks are also provided, together with picnic tables and benches. A pavilion building is situated near the entrance of the main section of the park. At present, this facility it is being used by a Nursery.



The Park is managed as a nature reserve, and attracts a wide variety of insect and bird life. But it is still a *great area for outdoor pursuits* such as walking, jogging, responsible dog walking, kite flying, picnicking and just enjoying the fresh air. Fishing (by permit, the Park Ranger will collect the fee from the lakeside) is allowed in the five acre lake, but the close season from March through to mid June, is strictly observed. Picnic tables and benches are provided for those that like to eat 'al fresco'. Car parking and cycle racks are available all year round but cycling is not allowed in the Park.

Wick Weeders	<i>Usually the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of each month</i>	Starting at <b>1.30 pm</b> (see the website & posters for confirmation of the dates). Equipment is provided. Help is always needed to maintain these gardens.
January Jaunt & AGM	<b>Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> January</b>	Starting at <b>2 pm</b> Start the year with a sociable and leisurely walk of approx <b>1 – 1.5 hours</b> around the Park, led by the Park Ranger. Dogs are welcome, but must be on a lead. Afterwards, enjoy some mulled wine and mince pies. Everyone is then invited to the AGM. <i>We all know that AGMs can be boring, but ours offers you the opportunity to have your say about the Park and the Events held there.</i>
Bird Song Walk	<b>Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> April</b>	Starting at <b>10 am (two hours)</b> . Both experienced and novice bird watchers are welcome. Last year we spotted, or heard, more than 20 species.
Skylarks 3K Race	<b>Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> April</b>	<b>7.30 pm</b> This race is organised in conjunction with the <b>Pitsea Running Club</b> . Open to all runners and power walkers. Supporters welcome.
